

2. As you can see in the image, Google automatically displays all available job ads based on your location. If they do not appear, go to the "Jobs" option using the bar above.

3. Check the date of the ad before applying so you don't waste your time.

4. Apply for roles you are an expert in. Most advertisements will include contact information, such as a phone number or email, within the ad.

5. Do not pay any money to an employer for an interview or for applying for a job. If they ask for money, you should leave immediately.
